AMDRY OPORIA





With a nod to Billy Wilder's much loved film and Shakespeare's Twelfth Night, Some Like it Hip Hop is a comical tale of love, mistaken identity, cross-dressing and revolution; all played out in ZooNation's trademark style of hip hop, comedy and physical theatre.

Some Like it Hip Hop, written by ZooNation founder Kate Prince and Felix Harrison, is the company's first full-length production since the award-winning West End smash hit, Into the Hoods.

Directed by Kate Prince, with original music by Josh Cohen and DJ Walde, the all star cast includes Tommy Franzén (So You Think You Can Dance, Blaze, Goldberg) Lizzie Gough (So You Think You Can Dance, Blaze) and Teneisha Bonner (Into the Hoods, Insane in the Brain, StreetDance 3D, Shoes).

ZooNation Dance Company was founded in 2002 by Kate Prince. In 2006, the company premiered Into the Hoods, which went on to become the longest running dance show the West End has ever seen. In 2010 ZooNation became a Resident Company at Sadler's Wells, and Kate Prince became an Associate Artist.

Kate is the Artistic Director of **ZooNation Dance Company** which she founded in 2002. In May 2010 she became an Associate Artist at Sadler's Wells and ZooNation became a **Resident Company**.

Kate has choreographed for two seasons of So You Think You Can Dance (BBC) and for the movie StreetDance 3D. She recently choreographed a special performance at the Laurence Olivier Awards to music from West Side Story played by the **BBC Symphony Orchestra**. Kate also choreographed for *Shoes* directed by Stephen Mear.

In 2008 Kate directed and co-choreographed Into the Hoods at the Novello Theatre which became both the first ever Hip Hop dance show to open in the West End and the longest running dance show in the West End's history. She also choreographed the cast of *Into the Hoods* for a special performance at Nelson Mandela's 90th Birthday Celebrations in Hyde Park.

Kate was lead choreographer for the Beijing Olympic and Paralympic Handover Ceremonies with dancers from ZooNation, CandoCo and The Royal Opera House.
